William Street Flats

A query was raised by residents from the William Street flats concerning stones that are protruding from the ground at the rear of the flats. There are concerns that residents could trip over them and it could cause an accident. It was discussed that we will bring this up at the Ward Meeting and explore the possibility of the area being concreted over.

Resurfacing of Ridgewood Crescent

Jerry was asked by a resident of Ridgewood Crescent as to what was happening with the road works as the middle area seems to have been left. To save time photos were taken of the areas in question, these were then passed to the Ward Coordinator.

We received an email from the Council High Ways Engineer with an explanation as to what the reason for delay was. This was due to complications regarding the concrete construction of the road surface. After all this works it was confirmed that the whole of Ridgewood Crescent was to be resurfaced. The works are expected to finish in the next weeks.

## Tenerife Buildings Fence

This area has been an eyesore for a long time in the area as it conveys a bad impression. It was discussed that this will be brought up at the Ward Meeting and we will ask for it to be clarified as to who is responsible for the upkeep of the fence. It was suggested that a brick wall may be a better alternative as that would more solid.
